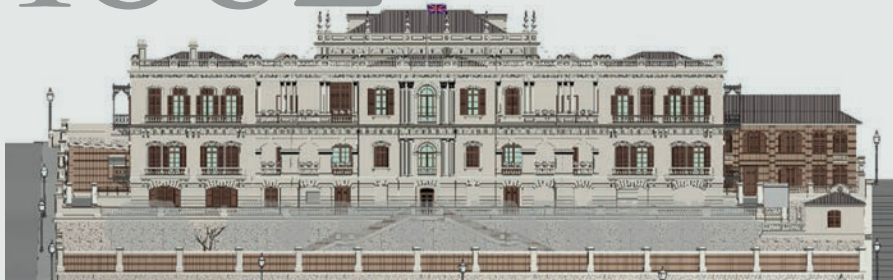

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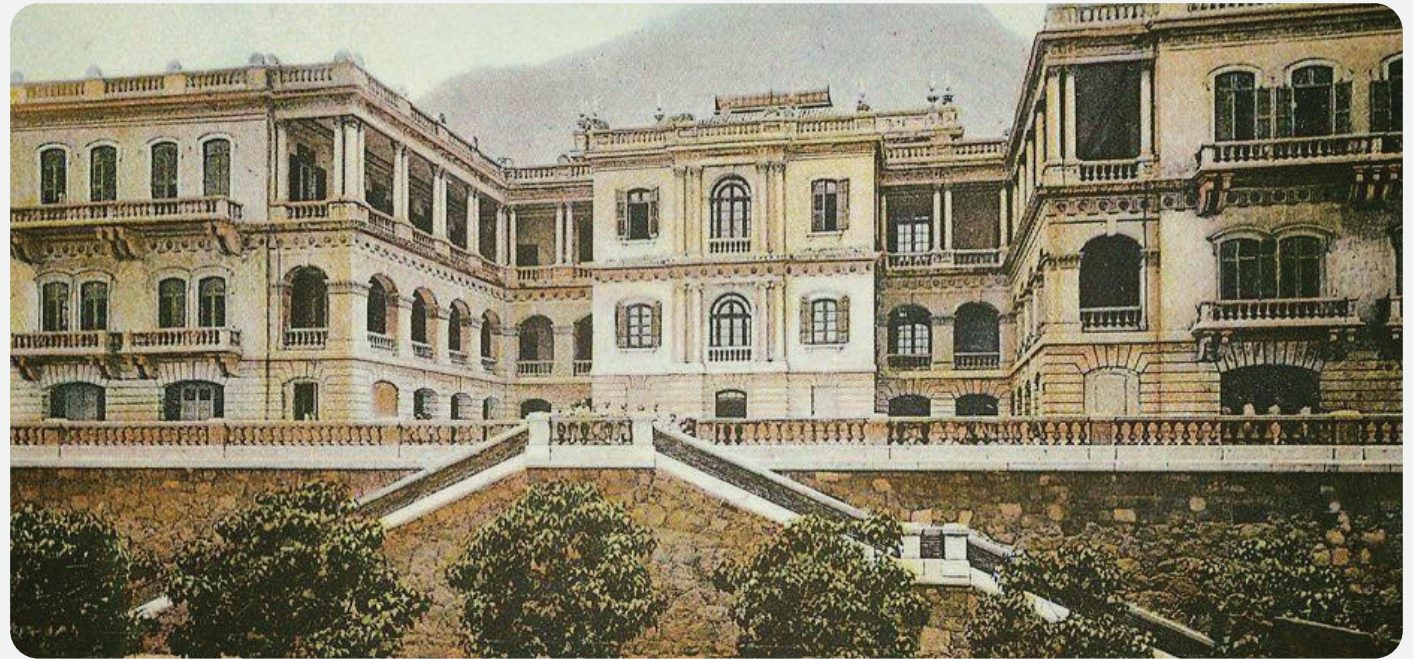

School History

Queen's College, originally named the Central School, is the first government school set up in Hong Kong in 1862. First located in Gough Street, Central, it provided western education to both Chinese and foreign students. In 1889, the new school building, at the junction of Aberdeen Street and Hollywood Road opened and the school was known as Victoria College. It was renamed Queen's College in 1894 and moved to the present site in Causeway Bay in 1950.

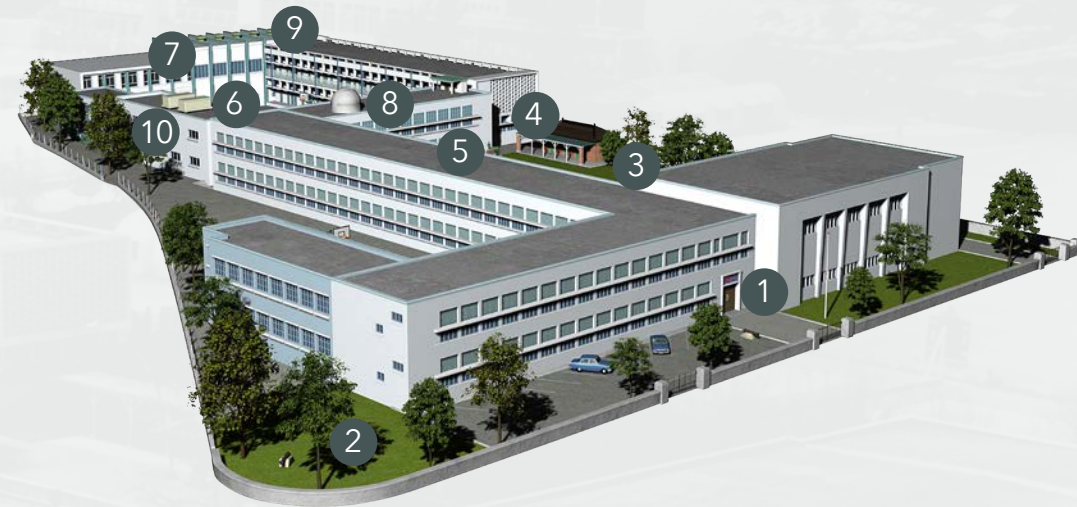

School Campus and Facilities

The school provides an ideal learning environment for students. There are 29 classrooms, 5 laboratories and various special rooms such as 2 Computer Rooms, 3 e-Learning Centres and 1 Lecture Room. Apart from the computerized library, there are facilities for sports and leisure including a gymnasium, an observatory, 2 playgrounds, Student Activity Centre, Scout Den and Morning Sun Court.

Besides, Queen's College History Museum was opened in March 2017 to celebrate the 155th anniversary of our school.

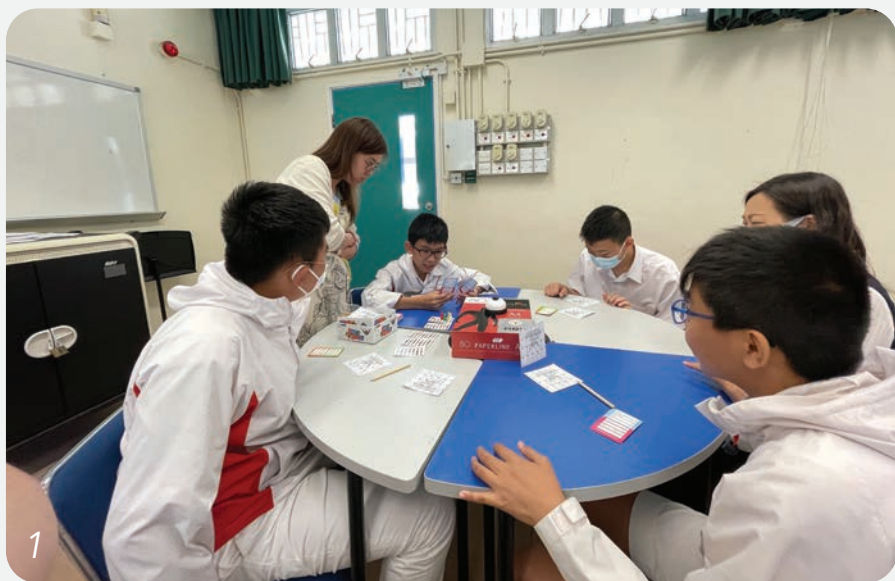

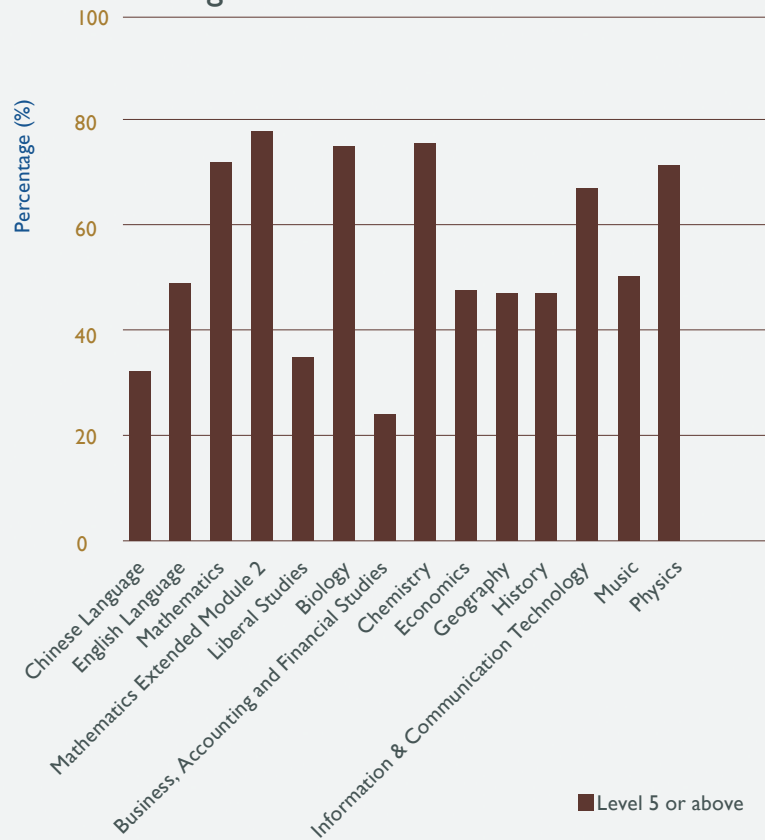

Percentage of students attained Level 5 or above

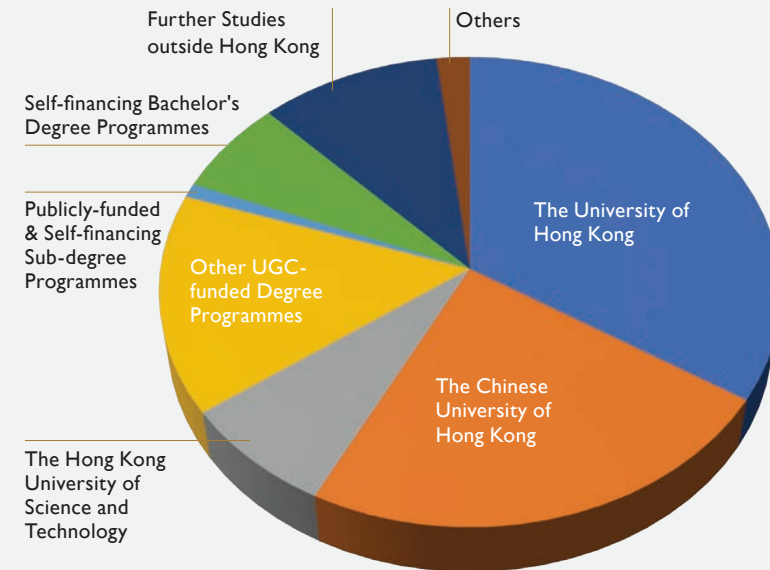
