Part: 1 Evaluation

Instructional Quality

The Japanese language program exhibits professional instructional quality and high student satisfaction across all evaluated courses, reflecting a strong overall evaluation where the instructors' performance achieved a rating of 4.9 out of 6 marks. Instructors are consistently praised for their clear explanations of complex grammar and vocabulary—earning 5.1 out of 6 marks for clear expression—as well as their meticulous preparation and deep subject-matter expertise. Students frequently highlight the teaching staff's patience, enthusiasm, and warm demeanor, which create a highly supportive and engaging classroom environment, mirrored in their score of 5.3 out of 6 marks for passionate teaching.

Practical Curriculum and Classroom Activities

The curriculum effectively prioritizes practical communication, with students identifying conversation practice and listening exercises as the most beneficial activities for their language development. This active instructional focus aligns perfectly with student motivations, which primarily revolve around media consumption, career advancement, and personal growth. Reflecting this success, the learning materials and textbook suitability received a strong rating of 4.9 out of 6 marks.

Lesson Pacing and Future Program Expansion

While the overall pacing of the courses is manageable for the majority—with the appropriateness of teaching speed receiving a solid 4.8 out of 6 marks. Looking forward, there is strong enthusiasm for continued study, with 40% of surveyed students already confirmed to continue and the remaining 40% expressing that they may continue. To support this ongoing enthusiasm, students have proactively proposed future specialized course modules focused on travel conversation and gaming terminology.
