Information on Selection of Applicants

- 1. Number of discretionary places for admission to Secondary One in 2026: 54
- 2. The criteria for the selection of S1 Discretionary Places and weightings are as follows:

Selection Criteria		
(a) Conduct and Academic Achievements	40%	
(b) Extra-Curricular Activities and Services	15%	
(c) Performance in Interview	45%	

- About 250 applicants will be selected for interviews based on their (1) conduct and academic performance in school and rank orders provided by the Education Bureau (73%), (2) achievements and awards in extra-curricular activities, and services(27%).
- The **individual interview** accounts for 45% of the overall assessment based on applicants' proficiency in Chinese and English, knowledge of Mathematics and Science, General Knowledge and communication skills.
- 3. To recognize applicants' achievements in areas other than academic work, applicants with outstanding performance in Music and/ or Sports will be separately selected for interviews. These applicants should provide relevant proofs of their achievements (e.g. results of Inter-Primary Schools Sports Awards, Instrumental Graded Examination Certificates, etc.). Overall assessment for admission is based on applicants' conduct, achievements in extra-curricular activities, their performance in the interview and the auditions or sports trials. About 20 applicants will be selected for interviews in this category and the quota for admission will not exceed 7.
- 4. Parents are strongly advised to study the terms stipulated in the application form carefully before submitting the application for their children. The application form can be downloaded from the school's homepage starting from 1 December 2025. For further details of the processing procedure, please refer to the Application Procedures overleaf.
