Revised Information on Selection of Applicants

1. Number of discretionary places for admission to Secondary One in September 2022:
43
2. Due to the severity of the Covid-19 pandemic, the Education Bureau made an announcement on 28 February 2022 about the special holiday arrangements in March and April in the 2021-2022 academic year, in order to facilitate the Compulsory Universal Testing Scheme. For the sake of safeguarding the health of both your child and our staff, the school has decided to cancel the 2022-2023 S1 Admission Interview. The selection criteria will be adjusted as follows:

Criteria for the Selection of S1 Discretionary Places	Weighting
1. Conduct and Academic Achievements	70%
2. Extra-curricular Activities and Services	30%

3. To recognize applicants' achievements in areas other than academic work, applicants with outstanding performance in Music and/ or Sports will be selected based on the applicants' relevant proofs of their achievements (*e.g. results of Inter-Primary Schools Sports Awards, Instrumental Graded Examination Certificates, etc.*) and should have attained an acceptable academic standard. The quota for this category **will not exceed 7**.
