a. An after-school English online reading and speaking course held by a native speaker	\$10,000	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ 17 junior form students (6 from S1, 7 from S2 and 4 from S3) attended the online course from November to December 2021 which consisted of 12 lessons with each one lasting one hour; most of them were able to attend the lessons on time.</li> <li>➤ They were engaged in the course, which enhanced their English reading and speaking skills.</li> <li>➤ They were given two handbooks prior to the course with reading texts covering different topics, notes about various reading and speaking skills and vocabulary building, etc.</li> <li>➤ On the whole, the students found the materials very useful and interesting.</li> <li>➤ They were very responsive in the lessons and had ample opportunity to speak in English.</li> </ul>
b. Art / cultural activity A visit to Hong Kong Disneyland	\$ 23,800	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ 20 students went to Hong Kong Disneyland where they had a STEM-related workshop on 21 December 2021.</li> <li>➤ They had a great time at the park and learned a lot about science at the workshop.</li> <li>➤ They reflected that they probably would not have been able to afford to visit the park on their own because of the high ticket prices.</li> </ul>
*Watching <i>Harry Potter and the Goblet of Fire</i> ™ in concert (From last academic year)	\$21736 (from last academic year)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ The show has been postponed multiple times due to the pandemic and according to the most current update, it will be held on 14 February 2023.</li> <li>➤ Some of the students that were meant to watch the show have already graduated, so a new list of students will be compiled.</li> <li>➤ According to the organizer, the current tickets remain valid for the same seats of the rescheduled performance.</li> </ul>
