Details of the competition are as follows:

Entry category	Old Boys, Parents of current students, teachers and students
Event	165th Anniversary School Tie Design Competition
Rules and instructions for entries	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. All entries must include the following TWO elements - 「皇仁 and/or QC」 AND 「165 and/or 一六五」.2. All entries must be graphic designs that can be drawn by hand, collage or with the assistance of a computer.3. No limit in size and color use.4. (a) For hand-drawn designs, there is no limitation of pigment. Examples include poster colours, water colours, pastels and markers. (b) For collage designs, examples of appropriate materials include coloured paper and coloured adhesive films. (c) For computer-assisted designs, there is no limitation of software. Examples include Photoshop, Illustrator, Canva and MS Paint.5. All contestants must submit a soft copy of their design. Soft copies must be in JPEG/PNG/PDF/AI format. Files size must not exceed 30MB with a resolution of no lower than 300dpi.6. Contestants must submit the design with entry forms. [See Appendix 1]7. Each contestant can submit one entry only.
Judging criteria	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Content (Relevance to the theme and clear message)2. Creativity (Originality and effective concept)3. Aesthetics (Way of presentation and visual impact)
Judging procedures	The judging panel will decide on the Champion, First runner-up, and Second runner-up. The design of the Champion will be used in the 165 th Anniversary School Tie.
Prizes	Champion: \$500 Gift voucher and a certificate of merit First runner-up: \$300 Gift voucher and a certificate of merit Second runner-up: \$100 Gift voucher and a certificate of merit
Adjudicators	First round adjudication: Principal Mr. Eric CHAN Cheung-wai, QCOBA President Mr. Kevin CHU Kai-ming and QCPTA Chairlady Ms. Christina CHAN Hoi-yan.
