B) Activities		
1. An after-school English online reading and speaking course as well as a DSE listening and speaking course held by native speakers for junior form students and senior form students respectively	\$22,920	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ 13 junior form students (9 from S1, 3 from S2 and 1 from S3) and 9 senior form students (6 from S4, 1 from S5 and 2 from S6) attended the corresponding online course from November to December 2022 which consisted of 12 lessons with each one lasting one hour; most of them were able to attend the lessons on time. ➤ Junior form students were given one handbook prior to the course with reading texts covering different topics, notes about various reading and speaking skills and vocabulary building, etc. while senior form students were given two handbooks prior to the course with notes about various listening and speaking skills, graded listening and speaking practices, and the Data File. ➤ On the whole, the students found the course materials useful, and were responsive in the lessons.
2. Art / cultural activity A visit to Hong Kong Disneyland	\$16,350	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ 11 students went to Hong Kong Disneyland where they joined the Y.E.S. program - Global perspectives: An adventure in Our Society on 26 December 2022. ➤ They had a great time at the park and learned a lot about different cultures and analytical skills. ➤ They reflected that they probably would not have been able to afford to visit the park on their own because of the high ticket prices.
3. Purchase of “Pre-DSE series- All-in-One Exercises with Mock Papers 3 and CD-ROM” for students’ self-learning	\$2,240	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ 20 junior form students were provided with “Pre-DSE series- All-in-One Exercises with Mock Papers 3 and CD-ROM” for their self-learning at home. ➤ They reflected that they enjoyed learning English at their own pace with reference to the useful and interesting materials.
